The Cooperating Service is going to be closed from 9.00 to 13.00 on the following dates:

Change in process for collecting provisional residence permit (MVV)

The procedure for collecting an MVV has changed as of March 2, 2026.

No longer MVV issuance form needed when collecting MVV

Until 2 March 2026, after a positive decision had been made, applicants would collect their MVV from a Dutch representation abroad. There, they had to fill out an MVV issuance form. This was an additional form required for issuing the MVV sticker.

However, as of 2 March 2026, this additional form is no longer required. The MVV can now be issued without one. A transition period applies until 31 March 2026.

Applications from 2 March 2026 or after

For all MVV applications approved from 2 March onwards, the MVV issuance form is no longer required.

Applications from before 2 March 2026

The IND is working on processing applications from before 2 March. This could take some time. This process is expected to be completed by 31 March. From 1 April 2026, all applications can be submitted without the MVV issue form.

Information and themed meeting

Online information meeting - 23 April 2026

Online application form for renewal of highly skilled migrant permit changed

Are you applying for renewal of the residence permit for the highly skilled migrant? You no longer need to enter the salary of the highly skilled migrant in the online application form. The self-declaration is sufficient. You hereby declare the following:

- The highly skilled migrant meets the applicable [salary criterion](#).
- The salary is in line with the market. 'In line with the market' means that the highly skilled migrant earns the same as what people earn on average in the same job.
- The salary is transferred to a bank account in the highly skilled migrant's name. The payment is made within one month.

No longer filling in the salary means less administrative burden for you and the IND. The new form does not change the rights and [obligations of a recognised sponsor](#).

Changes to contact persons

You must inform us of changes in your situation or that of the employee. In this newsletter, we would like to remind you to pass on any changes in contact persons.

It often happens that the IND wants to contact a recognised sponsor. But it is not always clear who is the (primary) contact person at that time. You must inform us of a change of



contact person using the [notification form](#). This also applies if you use an authorised representative.
