



Application for an extension of the provisional residence permit (MVV)

Application by sponsor or foreign national

About this form

Do you have a valid provisional residence permit (MVV)? And does your MVV expire within two weeks? And are you unable to travel to the Netherlands on time due to the current situation in the Middle East? If so, you can use this form to apply for an extension of the validity of your MVV. You can do this for yourself or for the person for whom you are the sponsor. For readability, in this form 'you' refers to the person for whom the MVV is intended.

If the information from your previous application has not changed, you do not need to submit any additional documents.

Note: Are you unable to travel on time for a reason other than the current situation in the Middle East? Or has your MVV already expired? If so, you cannot use this form.

Filling in the form

Print the form and then fill it in with pen. Always use a black or blue pen. Answer the open questions in block letters. Choose a selection box by filling it completely. If you made a mistake, cross out the incorrect box. And then fill in the correct box. Print the form in black and white or colour, on A4 paper and in full size.
