

Application for a residence permit for asylum family reunification

Application by sponsor

About this form

You have an asylum residence permit. You want to bring a family member from abroad to the Netherlands. This is called asylum family reunification. Your family member needs a residence permit to live with you in the Netherlands. A visa is also required to travel to the Netherlands in some situations. This visa is called a provisional residence permit (in Dutch: machtiging tot voorlopig verblijf or MVV). Use this form to apply for a residence permit and an MVV.

Before filling in the form

- Het Nederlandse <u>aanvraagformulier voor de verblijfsvergunning gezinshereniging asiel</u> vindt u op ind.nl/gezinshereniging-asiel.
- You can use this form to apply for one or more family members.
- Check the <u>requirements for this residence permit</u> at ind.nl/en/family-reunification.
 First, collect all required documents This is an important part of your application.
 Without documents, your application is not complete. The IND may then reject the application.

What does this form consist of?

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Filling in the form

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Fill in the form digitally and then print it. Or print the form and then fill it in with pen. Always use a black or blue pen. Answer the open questions in block letters. Choose a selection box by filling it completely. If you made a mistake, cross out the incorrect box. And then fill in the correct box. Print the form in black and white or colour, on A4 paper and in full size.

Submitting the form

Send the form and the documents to: IND, postbus 16, 9560 AA Ter Apel.

After your application

- Whether the application costs money depends on your situation and who you are
 applying for. An application for asylum family reunification is free of charge. An 8-ECHR
 application does cost money. You can read more about this in question 1. If you are
 charged a fee, you will receive a letter providing more information. View the costs of
 the application at ind.nl/en/fees.
- The <u>decision period for your application</u> is listed on ind.nl/en/decision-periods.
 Sometimes it takes longer, for example if not all documents are included with the application.
- Once the IND has received your application, you will receive a confirmation of receipt.
 An appendix is enclosed with this confirmation. You must use this to send the original documents. It is therefore important for these documents already to be available in the Netherlands. You do not need to resend the documents that were already examined during the asylum procedure.
- If the IND needs more information, you will receive a letter.
- The decision on your application is also set out in a letter from the IND.

DETAILS AND TYPE OF APPLICATION

1. Details of your family member(s)

You can use this form to submit two types of applications: asylum family reunification or family reunification based on Article 8 of the ECHR. Which application you submit depends on your situation and the family member for whom you are submitting the application.

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You must submit this application within 3 months of receiving your asylum residence permit.
